We've been walking a long ways and I was hungry-

She was hungry!

Apple Tree 4

The audacity!

Apple Tree 5

The nerve!

Apple Tree 6

What a sassy little girl!

Apple Tree 1

How would you like to have someone come along and pick something off of you?

Apple Tree 2

Who would want to pick something off of her?

Apple Tree 3

Just look at her!

Dorothy

Oh, dear, I keep forgetting I'm not in Kansas.

Scarecrow

(Aside to Dorothy)

I'll show you how to get apples.

(Out loud)

Come along, Dorothy, you don't want any of those apples!
